REQUIREMENTS AND COMMITMENTS

- Must be a minimum of 21 years of age
- Must agree to fingerprinting and background check by the Sheriff's Office
- Participate in training with the Volunteer Services Unit Program
- Attend training & evaluation for you and your horse
- Commit to patrol a required minimum of hours per year
- Attend meetings of the unit as designated
- Have a horse, or the use of one, that can be certified for use in the program
- To patrol outside your immediate area you must have access to a horse trailer and tow vehicle
- For park patrol your horse must be certified to interact with the public
- You may participate in special events if your horse has been properly certified
