



Attention Gas Station Owners /Attendants:

Protect Your Customers from "Skimmers" at the Gas Pump

Criminals are placing "skimmers" devices that capture consumers' credit and debit card information on card readers at the pump.

Florida State Statute 525.07 (10) requires each gas station to have security measures in place.

These measures can be:



- **Pressure Sensitive Security Tape**
 - **Electronic Prevention that disables the pump if opened without permission**
 - **Encryption of customer information at scanning device**




BROKEN SEAL
