General Overview:

A forensic dental evaluation was conducted at the office of the Palm Beach County Medical Examiner on April 26, 2005 at the request of Investigator Heron Ruiz. Present for examination was the decomposing body of a female recovered from a box on Route 27, 25 miles south of South Bay, Palm Beach County. The examination was conducted by Barbara L. Needell, DMD. At the time of the examination, there were no leads as to the identity of the deceased.

Forensic dental examination consisted of postmortem examination and documentation by digital photography and radiography.

Clinical Findings:

Extraoral Findings: Present for examination was the decomposing body of a female.

Periodontal Assessment: The deceased displayed a moderate to advanced destruction of alveolar structures, both from periodontal disease and tooth loss.

DENTAL CONDITION WORKSHEET

This chart should be filled out by a dentist following the complete visual examination of the dentition and review of the dental radiographs taken of the unidentified remains. The numbering of the teeth follows the format of the Universal numbering system with tooth #1 being the upper right third molar, tooth #16 being the upper left third molar, tooth #17 being the lower left third molar and tooth #32 being the lower right third molar. The description of the restorations present should include the surfaces involved (M, O, D, F, L), the restorative material used (amalgam, gold, porcelain, composite, temporary cement, etc.) and any other conditions that may be observed (endodontic treatment, pin retention, orthodontic brackets or bands, etc.). Do not leave any tooth numbers blank. If the tooth has no restorations note is as "virgin" or "present, no restoration". Other significant dental information can be noted at the bottom of this chart or on an attached sheet of paper.

Additional Dental Information:

Status of the Dentition: The deceased displayed a partial adult dentition, with several missing teeth (see odontogram and radiographs). The degree of dental pathology indicates a person with a minimal dental aptitude. The deceased had several porcelain fused to gold crowns. The deceased had a large diastema between the two front teeth.

*Teeth #12 is a pontic and #13 is an abutment of porcelain fused to gold bridge.

- *Tooth #14 has porcelain fused to metal crown.
- *Tooth #15 has a mesio-occlusal amalgam.
- *Tooth #29 has a disto-occlusal amalgam.
- *Tooth #30 has a porcelain fused to metal crown.
- *Tooth #31 has a porcelain fused to gold crown.

Evaluation of Antemortem Dental Records: Investigators have no leads as to the identity of the deceased.

Comparison: Due to an absence of antemortem information, no comparison was possible.


